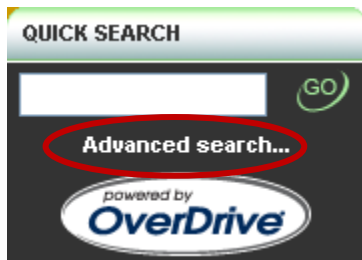



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
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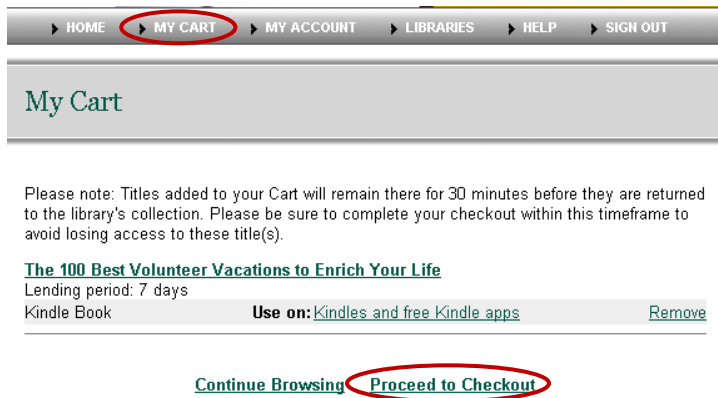
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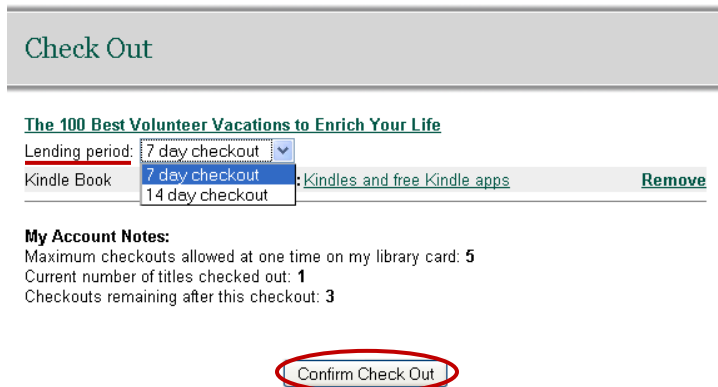
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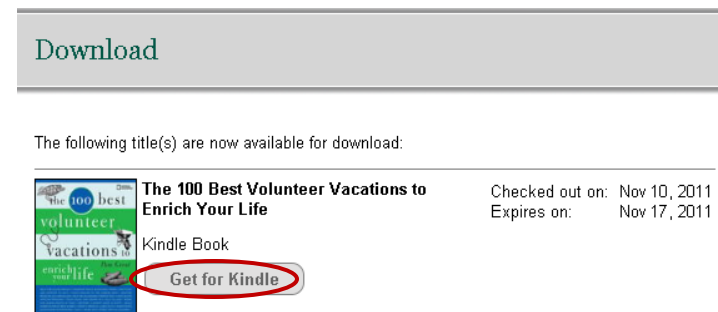
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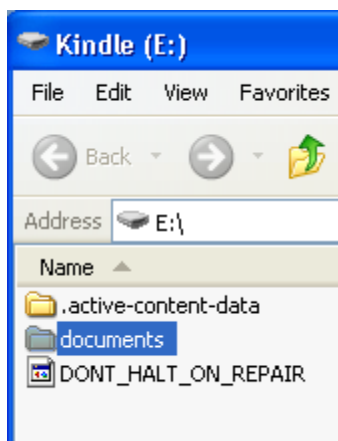
If you are using Internet Explorer 9, click "**Save,**" then "**Open Folder**" and skip to step 13.

12. The eBook will be saved to your computer's Downloads folder. The location of the Downloads folder varies depending on which operating system you have.

Windows XP: **Start** → **My Documents** → **My Downloads**

Windows Vista:  → **Documents** → **Favorite Links** → **Downloads**

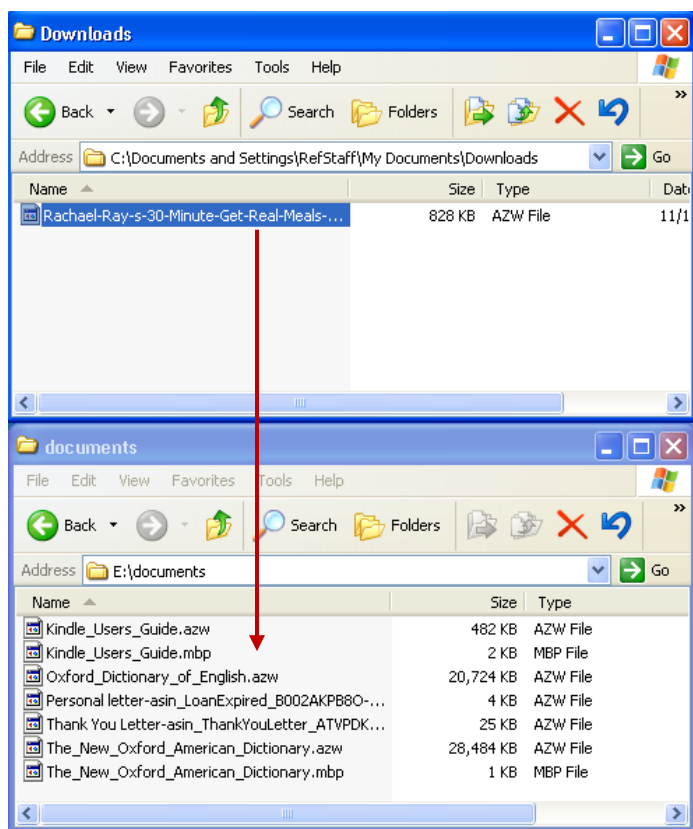
Windows 7:  → **Computer** → **Favorites** → **Downloads**



13. Connect your Kindle to the computer. (If an autoplay window pops up, select "**Open folder to view files,**" followed by "**OK,**" if necessary.)

The "**documents**" folder for your Kindle should appear.


If it does not appear, double-click "**My Computer**" (or "Computer") from the desktop. Then, double-click "**Kindle (E:)**" followed by "**documents.**"




14. Locate the eBook file that has been downloaded to your "**Downloads**" folder. Then, copy and paste (or drag) the file to your Kindle's "**documents**" folder.

15. Safely disconnect the Kindle from your computer.

In Windows XP, click the  icon at the lower right of the screen and select "**Safely Remove USB Mass Storage Device.**"

In Windows Vista, click the  icon and select "**Safely Remove Kindle.**"

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
